Responsible Pet Ownership: Living Safely with Dogs

Students in K-2 attended a responsible pet ownership workshop on Tuesday aimed at developing an understanding of how to interact safely with dogs. During this workshop students learnt:

- when dogs should be left alone
- things we should not do to dogs
- how can you tell if a dog is happy, scared or angry
- a safe way to approach and greet a dog
- what to do if approached by an unknown or aggressive dog
- choosing an appropriate pet for their family
- basic dog behaviour

Attendance

When your child is absent from school.

It is vital that information regarding why your child has not attended on a particular day is conveyed to the classroom teacher or the office within seven days of the first absence. For example: if a child is away on Monday Tuesday and Wednesday, the parent needs to advise the school the reason for that absence by the following Monday or the child is marked absent without explanation. This cannot be changed later even if we are notified.

In Term 1 we introduced a system which sends out an SMS notification to parents when their child has not arrived on time or when they are absent. So far this system has been well received and although we have had a couple of occasions where the SMS has gone out in error, overall it has been a success. ****Please note if your child arrives late without explanation you will receive an SMS to remind you to contact the school and give the explanation. You can then call or email to let us know.****

GOOD ATTENDANCE TIP:

Develop good routines: Children NEED routine. These habits are a good foundation that will help children throughout their school life and into the future;

Get uniforms, school bag and all school things organised the night before

Go to bed at the SAME, reasonable time each night

Get up at the SAME time each morning

Have breakfast at the SAME time each morning

Leave for school at the SAME time each day (be on time!)
