### Attendance

In Term 1, we introduced a system which sends out an SMS notification to parents when their child has not arrived on time or when they are absent. This system continues to work well and although we have the odd hiccup now and then, overall it has been a success.

It is important to understand that we CANNOT accept a reason for being late from a child. When a child is late, even only a few minutes after the bell, the parent must provide the explanation. If you are in a hurry and can't come in with the child, please phone or send an email to explain the reason as soon as you are able. When a child is absent, then returns without a written explanation, a note will be sent home to be filled in by the parents.

**TIP:**

Be positive about school in front of your child. If you have any concerns, talk to the school about the issue rather than create a negative image about school for your child. You will create problems for yourself and your child if you teach them to be negative about school.





## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Build your child's problem-solving skills: Rather than solving all their problems for them, help your child solve problems by asking them what they think is the best thing to do, or what do other kids do if this happens. Discuss ideas together rather than just giving them the answer or criticising the school. You are a role model for your child.
